## 4. Purpose and legal basis for the processing of personal data

**The purpose of the processing** is the nomination of the awardees - the award of the Bodossaki Foundation Prize to distinguished Greek scientists.

**The Legal basis** for the processing of personal data of the nominators and of the candidates is the legitimate interest of the Foundation, which consists in the proper fulfilment of its objectives as laid down in its Statutes (Article 6(1)(f) of GDPR).

# 5. Retention period of personal data

The data contained in the application and the related documents will be deleted within 20 years from submission of the application and award of the Excellence Award of Bodossaki Foundation.

## 6. Disclosure and Transfer of Personal Data

Data contained in applications and related documents shall not be disclosed to third parties other than the following recipients:

- a) The Members of the Excellence Award Committee composed of experts in the relevant disciplines.
- **b)** The Nominees nominated by the Nominators themselves at the time of submission of their application.
- c) The members of the Board of Bodossaki Foundation.
- **d)** The Company under the name "NimaWorks" (12 Rizariou Street, Halandri, Athens, Greece) which supports the platform for the submission of the digital nomination applications.
- e) Providers of IT services and products that support the operation of the network, information systems and applications of the Foundation. These providers have undertaken commitments to protect personal data.

## 7. Rights

You can exercise the following rights by sending a request to the above email address (mentioned under 2):

- a) <u>The right of access:</u> You can request information on the processing of data, as well as copies of the data we hold.
- b) <u>The right to rectification</u>: You may request that errors, inaccuracies and omissions in the data are corrected.

- c) <u>The right to erasure:</u> You may, under certain conditions provided for in the data protection legislation, request that your data be erased.
- d) <u>The right to restrict processing</u>: You may request that we restrict the processing of personal data in case of doubt about their accuracy, as well as in case the data is no longer necessary for the original purpose but for legal reasons cannot yet be deleted.
- e) <u>The right to object to processing.</u> You may object to the processing of personal dataIf, however, there are compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the rights and interests that you will invoke, we may refuse your objection, stating our reasons.
- f) <u>The right to portability of personal data:</u> If you have applied as a nominator, you can request that we transfer your data to another organisation or provide it to you.
