The **Bodossaki Foundation** is a public benefit organisation founded in 1972 to continue the support given to Greek society by its founder, Prodromos Bodossakis Athanassiades.

Since its founding it has made available over €450 million to further its aims.

> Today the Bodossaki Foundation also acts as a catalyst for fostering a broader culture of contribution in Greek society, by managing resources on behalf of third parties – legators, international organisations, and other major donors - who wish to fund programmes with significant social impact that seek to address critical needs in education, healthcare, the protection of the environment and the empowerment of Civil Society.
